Dear Mr. Seljeseth,

Here are some brief answers to questions in your recent letter:

- 1. Each module in kit and assembled form comes with a set of user tests to check each input and output for proper functioning. In addition, we have a User's Guide to get beginners started with our system. We are also in the process of preparing a very complete manual which will contain basic information on each module as well as many patches for the beginner and advanced synthesist. This should be ready befor summer 1981.
- 2. The discounts apply to each purchase and are not cumulative. If you were to purchase two panels of modules in February for \$1500 and two panels in June for another \$1500, there would be no discount on either purchase. For this reason, it is little more economical to purchase an entire system at one time if your budget permits. On the other hand, you might choose to start with a single panel, getting familiar with the Serge system, and then deciding which modules you would need to further expand your system. The Series '79 system is mainly presented to give a suggested system lay-out, and most individuals prefer to choose their own complement of modules, sometimes very similar to the ones in the Series '79, sometimes with different lay-outs, accenting the modules they feel are more useful for their own application.
- 3. Our system is relatively easy of interface with other systems. We use a positive trigger/gate at about +5 volts amplitude. Audio signals are around studio level (0 db), input impedances are high, output impedances are low. You might wish to include on your panel some adaptors for whatever type of connector you use on you other systems (mini-jacks, phone jacks, etc.). In one of our panel inches we can fit 4 adaptors (eight jacks).
- 4. Shipping to Iceland for the items you mentioned will probably run about \$75. We can ship any items and collect the freight charges on delivery.
- 5. Best way to pay is to transfer funds to our bank through your local bank. Here is the address:
